₅ It's Souper Bowl Sunday!

Did you know that 1 in 7 Americans face hunger every day? Some 48 million Americans live in poverty and 16 million children live in food insecure households. Souper Bowl

Sunday is an annual tradition that mobilizes people to care for individuals in their local communities who are hungry and in need. Jesus calls us to care for the hungry and poor. Direct giving and serving in the name of Jesus provides lasting hope to those in need.

Youth will be at the doors today following each service as part of Souper Bowl Sunday to collect monetary donations. Checks can be made out to St. Luke's with "souper bowl" in the memo. Canned goods collection will run through February 11th for particularly soup, pasta sauce, sauce, canned fruit and juice.

On a monthly basis, a dedicated group of St. Luke's volunteers meet at Cabot Food Bank to pack bags for distribution. The monthly ministry started 18 years ago as a project for the "30-hour famine." Many of the original youth have since graduated and their parents continue to serve in the ministry. Additional young people serve when they are home from college or work. The group meets at 6 pm on the Monday before the third Wednesday of every month. All are welcome to come and share in the ministry. The food bank is located at Cabot United Methodist Church on Winfield Road.

As part of Souper Bowl, St. Luke's has collected more than \$7,500 and over 1,500 in food items for hunger relief efforts since 2000.



St. Luke's continues to remember those affected by the devastating hurricanes and flooding last year. St. Luke's is in the midst of collecting financial donations toward providing relief to victims of the hurricanes through NALC Disaster Relief. To date, \$2,863 of the

\$5,000 goal has been collected. The donation drive is being extended to Easter. Financial donations collected today as well

as Lenten coin boxes will be applied toward the goal.
