Get Yourself To A Class

The Methodist church, started by John Wesley in the 18th century, got its start as supplemental meetings to regular weekly church attendance. They started off with three types of meetings during the week for people who were committing themselves to deepen their faith and to follow Jesus more fully.

The Band Meeting: This was a group of five folks who would gather together in an accountability group. They would confess temptations and sins, hold each other accountable, and lift one another up in prayer. Not everyone who was a Methodist ended up in a band meeting.

The Class Meeting: This was a group of about 12 people who invested intentionally in each other’s lives. They would meet once a week and would focus on one question, “How is it with your soul?”

The Society Meeting: This was the largest group meeting. Folks would gather together each week to hear preaching and teaching from John Wesley and other leaders. In order to be a part of the Society Meeting, participants had to attend a Class Meeting.
