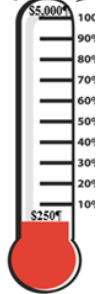


**Safety On Campus** – The St. Luke’s Risk Assessment Task Force has carefully assessed St. Luke’s campus and identified multiple items that are needed to improve the safety for all who use the church grounds and protect what God has given us. These items and the associated costs are:

- 4 smoke alarms= \$110
- 5 smoke/carbon monoxide alarms= \$260
- 9 fire extinguishers= \$720
- 4 first aid kits= \$60
- 2 blood clotting kits = \$250
- 2 automatic external defibrillators (AEDs)= \$3,600

**The estimated total cost of these items = \$5,000**



Please consider how you can support the efforts to fund these essential life safety items to enhance the protection of God’s precious members and visitors to St. Luke’s.

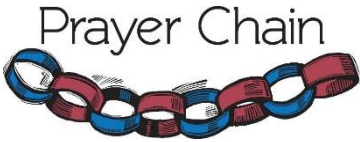
