

North American Lutheran Church (NALC) Disaster Response Loads Truck for Hurricane Harvey

Flood buckets, cleaning supplies, bottled water, and many other emergency supplies were loaded Monday, August 28, 2017, for delivery to Texas for Hurricane Harvey relief.

NALC and the HARP Mission volunteers are providing the manpower to help hundreds of these families. The HARP Mission serves southeast Ohio in non-disaster times, providing material goods, home repairs, and job training to low income families. When a disaster strikes, NALC volunteers are ready to ship emergency supplies from the national warehouse in Caldwell. These are items that are not easily available in impacted communities.

To support Hurricane Harvey relief efforts, you may send donations to St. Luke's Domestic Disaster Relief by dropping off a check or mailing a check to the church office and we will forward to the NALC Disaster Relief program.


