Land Acknowledgement - JENI

We acknowledge those indigenous tribes to Oklahoma: the Wichitas, Caddos, Plains Apaches, and the Quapaws, as the original custodians of the land in this place. We respect those who came here as a result of the Trail of Tears: the Choctaw, Cherokee, Creek, Chickasaw and Seminole people. We grieve the violence done to native language, culture, and personhood. One of Mosaic's core values is reconciliation and we embrace the ongoing work of reconciliation among all God's creation including the 39 tribes who call this land home.
