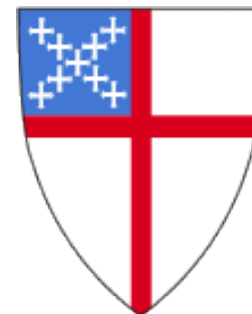
How does it work?

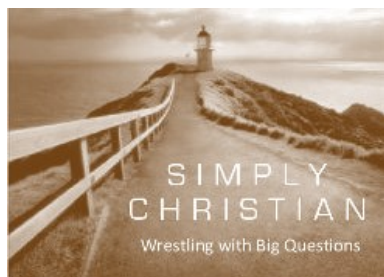

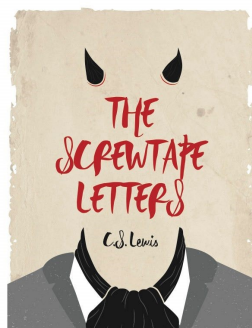

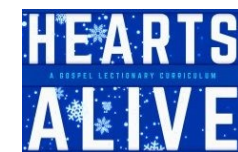
Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori-based approach to faith formation for children ages 3 to 12.

It is theologically sound, systematic, and rich in Scripture, liturgy, and sacred history. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd takes place in an atrium, a sacred, hands-on space in which both children and catechists can hear, ponder, and celebrate the essential mysteries of the Christian faith as revealed in scripture and the liturgy.
