Dear St. Stephen's Community,

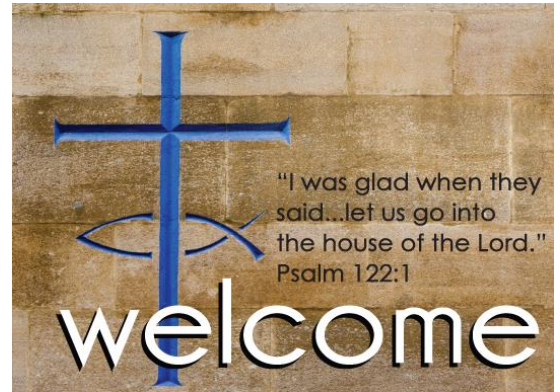
