Those who cannot remember the past are condemned to repeat it (George Santayana 1863-1952)

July 4th is one of my favorite holidays. As a child, I went with my family to the Arch in St. Louis to see the annual Air Show and sometimes, fireworks set off from barges. Now I typically spend it relaxing with family and enjoying the firework displays of nearby communities from the swing on our front porch. As with everything else, the holiday will be different this year for many of us. And though understanding and marking our history as a nation is more important than ever, I urge you to celebrate this occasion in a safe and socially distant manner.

Here is a prayer from 1892 Book of Common Prayer, a prayer for the Unity of God's People:

Let us pray,

O God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, our only Savior, the Prince of Peace; Give us grace seriously to lay to heart the great dangers we are in by our unhappy divisions. Take away all hatred and prejudice and whatsoever else may hinder us from godly union and concord: that as there is but one Body an one Spirit, and one hope of or calling, one Lord, one Faith, one Baptism, one God and Father of us all, so we may be all of one heart and of one soul, united in one holy bond of truth and peace, of faith and charity, and may with one mind and one mouth glorify these; through Jesus Christ our Lord. 
