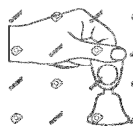
## Pitch-In on Sunday, June 2

## Choir visitation from the Cathedral

On **August 15**, *Coro Latinoamericano*, the Latino choir from our Cathedral, will be here for a workshop. More information will follow.

Coro Latinoamericano was founded in 2000, in response to Christ Church Cathedral's growing number of Hispanic parishioners. The choir leads the 1 p.m. Santa Misa Sunday service and combines Anglican tradition with Latino music and culture.
