

The Coming Financial Collapse And The Coming Of The Lord

I've not written about this in several years but feel impressed to do so now because many Christians have fallen back asleep and the Church has continued on its way—sliding into perdition. It's interesting to note for those who have the Eye of the Eagle the similarities between America, Israel of the Bible and the Church. All of these have a “common denominator” (the one true God) or several “common threads.” These being:

- 1. Worship (former worship) and honor of Jehovah God.**
- 2. Rebellion against God and His laws.**
- 3. Treatment of the poor and helpless.**
- 4. Worship of idols, particularly money and materialism.**
- 5. All three have had civil wars; the Church is still involved in its Civil War**

6. Refusal to repent, even in the face of God's obvious judgments. Instead of repenting, the Church and America—like Israel of the Bible—have hardened their Hearts and defied God. There is no fear of God in the Church.

So many scriptures, particularly in the Old Testament, are so very relevant to both America and the Church. Of course it is the duty of the Church to preserve America but instead of being a preservative to the godly culture established by our founding fathers, like Israel and Judah of the Bible, most of the Church has become a prostitute and pursued “many lovers” such as money and fame. This has resulted in there being little difference between the Church and the world.

This was again vividly brought to my attention yesterday morning in a vision I received from the Lord. I was attending a church and I was wearing a suit and tie but I was barefooted in the vision. The church was sparsely attended. It was a typical sanctuary of pews and aisles that would seat about 300 people but there were only about 40-50 people there. I was walking in an aisle behind a pew where one man was seated at the end and at the other end, lying crumpled in the corner was a hymn book. It was so badly crumpled that it was almost in a ball even though it was one of the hard back type hymnals I grew up with as a Methodist and Baptist.

I turned down the main isle leading to what would be the pulpit and altar at the center of the church (few churches have an altar today, hmmm?) but instead it led to the bathroom. I entered the bathroom and noticed a razor sitting on the sink but there was no shaving cream. Then the vision ended.

This is an easy vision to interpret but rather than give the interpretation I am encouraging you to meditate on it and send me your interpretations.

Now you must understand that I do differentiate between the Church and the Bride—they are not the same. In fact there are three divisions in the Body of Christ—three is God’s perfect number. The Bride would never do the things most of the Church does—she is the real Queen of Heaven (not the power Ashtaroth of the Dark Kingdom who calls herself the “Queen of Heaven”) and like the Proverbs 31 bride only does her husband “good.” The Lord Jesus told my wife back in 1998 that He “would never marry Himself to a prostitute.”

Now you may not believe the Bride and the Church are separate but there are many scriptures that show there is a difference and I will briefly mention one that the Lord has been reminding me of again for the last few months since the Spirit asked me to go back and concentrate on the

things Jesus said in the Gospels, no doubt because He wants me to see something new here.

“Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten Virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the Bridegroom. Now five of them were wise, and five were Foolish. Those who were foolish took their lamps and Took no oil with them, but the wise took oil in their Vessels with their lamps. But while the bridegroom was Delayed, they all slumbered and slept. And at midnight a Cry was heard: ‘Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out To meet him!’ Then all those virgins arose and trimmed Their lamps. And the foolish said to the wise, ‘Give us Some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.’ But the Wise answered, saying, ‘No, lest there should not be Enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, And buy for yourselves.’ And while they went to buy, the Bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in With him to the wedding; and the door was shut. Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, ‘Lord, Lord, open to us!’ But he answered and said, ‘Assuredly, I Say to you, I do not know you.’ Watch therefore, for you Know neither the day nor the hour n which the Son of Man is coming.” ■ Matthew 25:1-13

Now it’s quite obvious that these ten virgins represent the Church because they were *all* waiting for the Bridegroom; nobody in the world or any other religion is waiting or

looking for the Bridegroom. It is also obvious that the oil represents the Holy Spirit as He is often represented in the Scriptures as being oil, i.e., the virgin olive oil for the lamps commanded by the Lord to Moses for the Tabernacle. And don't forget this part, the fire of God was never to go out. Remember, Eli's sons were judged and put to death by the Lord not only because they were wicked but also because they allowed the Lamp of God to go out (1 Sam. 3:3); they did not replenish the oil.

So clearly there is separation here in the Body of Christ and the distinguishing characteristic between "wise" and "foolish" has to do with the wise having more oil, perhaps a reference to the Baptism of the Holy Ghost or Baptism of Power as we refer to this third work of Grace, than did the foolish virgins.

We are definitely in the season of this event, the Second Coming of Jesus Christ, and so we should be prepared and do all that we can to be numbered in the Bride so that we can escape all these things which are coming upon the earth—earthquakes, nuclear wars, massive death and destruction.

Now concerning the USA, I would refer you back to my vision on 911 recorded in *Revelations From God*, Vol. I, p. 49. This vision depicts the eventual attack on Washington, D.C., by a Muslim army and although it was not in the vision, I

believe America must, like Israel of the Bible, go into captivity because that is one of God's judgments that He always uses against all nations along with famine, financial collapse, war and death.

Often these judgments occur in cycles because the populace and God's covenant people don't recognize the signs:

"We do not see any signs; there is no longer any prophet ..."

■ Psalms 74:9

Remember, just like in the Bible days of Israel there are always more false prophets than genuine ones and the message of the false prophets is always the same as seen in Jeremiah: "Peace, prosperity, health, wealth, the good life, the Blessing, etc." whereas the message of God's true prophets is likewise always the same: "Repent!"

America has received many warnings and "signs" in different ways. Both 911 and the financial collapse of Lehman Brothers in 2008, were exactly 7 years (God's number of completion) apart and were a "sign" to America, both being against the financial system of the country. It's God saying: "Repent, and turn back to Me. Your money can't save you." And don't forget the warnings to the Church in both Jeremiah and Revelation in the same regard depicting the Church as being "wealthy" and in Rev. 18:7, "I sit as a queen

(remember, I said earlier how the true Bride is the Queen of Heaven), and am no widow, and shall in no wise see mourning.” Oh, what a sad picture is the church today; she looks nothing like the Queen of Heaven or the people Jesus died for. When will she arise in maturity and begin to resemble the Lord Jesus as the Five-fold ministers (Eph. 4) and foundational offices of Apostle and Prophet (Eph. 2:20) are supposed to bring her? Sad to say most churches are doing nothing for the Kingdom because as the Lord told me in 1991, they’re “being led by religious spirits” and not the Holy Spirit.

America is standing on the brink of financial collapse as is most of the world except for China, although as an export economy China will eventually succumb. The U.S. stock market has continued to rise but it’s because of greed—the major spirit over New York City—and the belief, like the church of Rev. 18, “I will never see mourning” but the whole system is going to collapse and I’ve known it since the early ‘90s; I just don’t know the timing but it is very close now, certainly within the next 1-3 years and this is obvious to the secular world—those who have eyes to see. In addition, because the U.S. continues to spend like a drunken sailor and is deficit spending right now \$200B a month (that’s \$2.4 T a year), which is unheard of, all this money “creation” is fueling the stock market but don’t forget an eerily similarity with Zimbabwe—in 2008 Zimbabwe had the best performing

stock market in the world but then you lost all your money because of inflation.

What occurred in 2008/2009 with the collapse of many banks and financial institutions was that the governments of the world led by the U.S. Fed propped up these institutions and did not allow them to fail by printing money. Of course this eventually leads to inflation and does not resolve the problem. Duh! How can you solve a debt problem by creating more debt? Both the Fed and ECB (European Central Bank) balance sheets have exploded to about \$8 T which is unheard of. The only reason Europe has not collapsed is because in Nov., 2011, the ECB gave “free” loans to the banks to keep them from collapsing taking anything (old tires, broken down cars, sovereign debt, etc.) as collateral. But they didn’t solve the problem; they merely staved off a collapse in Greece and all the Greek debt held by European banks but Greece cannot repay its debt and will eventually default; they will probably leave the Euro Zone after the next elections so that they can return to their own currency and thus try to inflate their way out of debt.

But now Spain, a country too big to bail out, is looming ever larger. I told Evelyn over a year ago that Spain was the real problem because their problem is more severe and their economy is much larger than Greece. Spain unemployment is almost 24% and real estate is in a shambles, even worse

than here, so it's obvious that the banks are in serious trouble because of unemployment and the economy.

When will the financial collapse come? I don't know exactly. The Lord never has shown me but it will be swift and sure. However, don't be alarmed! Remember, if you're in covenant with God then He is obligated to provide for you and take care of you. Praise the Lord! The Lord began showing us back in the '90s that He would use us in this time through the Gift of Working of Miracles to feed thousands just like Jesus did. But famine is coming! Other judgments are coming although we feel that many of these will occur after the Bride is taken to Heaven as pictured in Revelation.

I hope that this teaching has not alarmed you but has caused you to shake yourself, examine your life, repent of any sins and serve the Lord to the best of your ability until He comes. Maranatha!
