**The very first monthly newsletter we published at CCI almost 30 years ago had an article titled, “The Glory of the Latter House.” Years later when Evie and I were scheduled to minister at a big convention in South Africa in April of the following year, the Lord, as He often does, began to give me the message in December and January months before. During that time He spoke to me about “the last 3 major moves of God.” Now you’ll often hear people ask, “What is God doing now?” or you might also hear people say, “God is doing this now” or this “move of God is going on. And those statements are true. Let’s face it—none of us has the intellect nor capacity to understand God. He is so far beyond our comprehension and that of the angels. In fact, as I’ve written many times in these monthly articles, you should fast and pray in a serious way and ask the Lord to take you to Heaven and allow you to stand in His counsel. It will open your eyes and blow your mind! Even the angels there will often shake their heads at the wisdom and knowledge coming from the Lord and they’ve been with him for probably millions of years.**

**Yes, God is always moving—that’s why the Spirit of the Lord is typed as a clean flowing river—He’s never stagnant. And if you don’t “move” with Him when He moves you will be left behind. That’s why it’s good to develop the “Eye of the Eagle.”**

**But although the Lord is involved in many different “moves” He shared with me back then that there were only 3 major moves of God left and He used Eve to release the first major move back in 1996 in**

**Johannesburg, South Africa. It was a move of *mercy!* Often we find ourselves thinking, “How can God use me to do something great like that” and we think that He cannot use us to do great things like He did David and Elijah but you must remember, He has to use somebody to fulfill prophecy and if you will develop the Eye of the Eagle you might just see that He wants to use you!**

**So there are still 2 major moves of God left. What are they you say? Well, I’m glad you asked or I would have to quit writing right here. They are “Glory” and “Judgment.” So now this brings us back to the title of this article, doesn’t it? All of prophecy must be fulfilled and that includes this move of Glory that will make the “latter” house or temple much more glorious than the one being spoken about in Haggai. But it also invites us—if we are smart—to study the situation in Haggai if we want to assist the Lord in bringing in this great move of Glory that I’ve written about in the past.**

**We are very close now to its beginning yet we can see the reason why there has been a delay—it’s the same as in Haggai’s time and why he was commissioned to speak to the people and to write the book of Haggai. Like most of the church today, the Jews of Haggai’s time had experienced their love and enthusiasm for the things of God decline. Just like Jesus chastises several of the churches in Revelation for letting their “love for Him grow cold” these Jews, after initially becoming excited about returning home and rebuilding the Temple had stopped work and began to work on living “their best life now.” They moved God down the list and material things took precedence over the things of the Lord.**

**“Then the word of the LORD came by Haggai the prophet, saying, ‘Is it time for you yourselves to dwell in your paneled houses, and this temple to lie in ruins?’ Now therefore, thus says the LORD of hosts: ‘Consider your ways!’” Ω Haggai 1:3-5**

**The book of Haggai is one of the most accurately dated of all the books in the Bible and it was written sometime in the last 4 months of the year 520 B.C. in the “second year of Darius” who was a general under the Persian king Cyrus the Great.**

**The message from Haggai—if we can see it with the Eye of the Eagle—to us today is plain: “Why are you not building the Temple of the Lord? Why are you engrossed in materialism and building your own houses while the House of the Lord—the Temple of the Lord—lies in ruins?”**

**A dilapidated house is a sure sign of neglect by the person in charge isn't it? And the “Owner” does not want to live in such a house, does He? No, because it is a sure sign that He is not respected nor honored by the person in charge of the Temple and therefore the body become defiled instead of a Temple of holiness to the Lord.**

**So the Spirit of the Lord is waiting patiently for us to stop playing church and building sand castles while His “house lies in ruins.” But He will soon move in this new end-time great move of Glory and Isaiah 60 will be fulfilled for those who have prepared their vessels to be vessels of gold as Paul wrote to Timothy. This move will coincide with “gross darkness” filling the earth. And at this time there will be unprecedented miracles, signs and wonders. In fact, as I've written before, the raising of the dead will be as common as praying for headaches is today. God will use His Bride as she has prepared herself and she will manifest His glory to a sin-sick, crying, dying world to bring about the great end-time harvest just before the rapture after which the wrath of God is poured out upon those unbelievers who are left behind. Praise the Lord! Maranatha!**
