

THE KINGLY ANOINTING

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Today as I was in prayer and meditation I felt strongly impressed of the Lord to share this teaching with you. If you will understand it, meditate on it over several weeks to allow the Holy Spirit to speak to you about it, and then practice it, your life will never be the same. And it is especially important in these days in which we live for you to understand this concept that the Spirit communicated to me back in the 70's and 80's because the world is standing on the brink of a complete financial collapse.

We have shared in our preaching, teaching and writing—including many articles on this website—the fact that the Lord's been telling the Church since the 1980's to "get out of debt." And I've also shared that I've known about this financial collapse since the 80's as well; I just did not know the timing but I knew that the crisis of 2008, as bad as it was, was not it; however, the next one will be and we're in the initial stages of that one now.

Unfortunately, as most Americans know, the debt crisis of 2008-2010 was never solved. In fact, it's been made worse by more borrowing. Instead of allowing those businesses and banks who made bad loans to bear the cost of those loans and fail, the governments of America, Europe and Great Britain forced their citizens to accept these loans. In other words, the bad loans were transferred from the balance sheets of the banks to the balance sheets of governments. Now, as you know, this debt crisis is blossoming again and its resolution (though there is no solution) will eventually lead to the financial system of Revelation controlled by Satan through the Beast.

This fact alone makes it very important that you understand the Kingly Anointing and the fact that, although there are many

different anointings, every Christian has a three-fold anointing: prophet, priest and king. If you don't understand the Kingly Anointing and how to exercise it then you won't know what to do if there is famine and you have no way to put food on the table. God gave His people a Kingly Anointing and He expects us to exercise it. In fact, if you'll learn to exercise your Kingly Anointing you can drive all the drug dealers, abortion clinics, porn operators—everything unclean—out of your community and county. Few Christians or churches seem to understand what I'm sharing with you or else they would be involved in spiritual warfare in their communities.

Recently we were ministering in the South in Alabama, Georgia and Florida and I remarked to my wife as we were driving: "You can tell you're in the South because every hundred yards there's a police car and a church." Then as we were being interviewed on Christian television I made this same remark and then added: "How come with all these churches every 100 yards the devil's still in control of Augusta, Georgia?"

Well, I knew the answer to that question—to me it was a rhetorical question. The reason the devil's still in control of cities, counties, states and countries is very simple: Christians and churches are not taught anything about the Kingly Anointing and how to exercise it in spiritual warfare. It's imperative, my brothers and sisters, that you understand these concepts because the Lord told me in 1980 that "the power of the devil will become so strong in the last days that only those Christians who are strong in the Word and faith will survive."

Now let's consider some scriptures that will help you understand your Kingly Anointing so that you can walk in your authority by exercising this anointing.

One morning in 1997 the Holy Spirit spoke to me when I awoke and He said: "The world is waiting for a true demonstration of the Gospel." If we can properly understand the Kingly Anointing we can learn how to not only *be* a demonstration of the Gospel but also the Kingdom of God. Few in Jesus' day understood this concept but

one who was not even in covenant with the Lord, a Roman centurion, did. But the people did recognize that there was something different about Jesus—that He was a teacher so they honored and respected Him by calling Him *Rabbi*. But they knew there was something different about Him than all the other teachers and it was the Kingly Anointing!

“And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine: for He taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.” (Mt. 7:28-29)

Even the religious leaders who opposed Him because they lacked spiritual acumen recognized that He had authority. Notice this scripture:

“And when He entered the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came up to Him as He was teaching, and said to Him: „By what authority are you doing these things and who gave you this authority?“” (Mt. 21:23)

Now, how did they know that He had authority? By the signs, wonders and miracles that He performed! We see it right here in this verse—“by what authority *are you doing these things ...?*” Jesus Himself even told them to believe Him—the words He spoke—because of the signs. But they had a problem; they didn’t honor or respect Him as the Messiah because they knew He was “the carpenter’s son.” You see, they could not recognize the Kingly Anointing. Had they been able to do so perhaps they would have understood as the centurion did *how* He exercised this Kingly Anointing. And if you don’t understand it you won’t know how to exercise your Kingly Anointing.

Now let’s consider what the centurion understood by just observing Jesus’ life and ministry. This is such a beautiful and powerful scripture—be sure to meditate on it day and night because it will help you learn to exercise your Kingly Anointing.

“And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him, and saying, „Lord, my servant

lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.” And Jesus saith unto him, „I will come and heal him.” The centurion answered and said, „Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed. For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it.” When Jesus heard it, he marveled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.”
(Mt. 8:5-10)

Now, you need to meditate on scripture so that the Spirit of God can do His job of “guiding you into all truth” but just from a casual reading what do we learn from these verses? Well, there are a number of things:

1. The centurion recognized that Jesus possessed authority and that Jesus derived that authority from Someone else. Notice his statement in the more literal translations such as the ESV—“For I too am a man under authority...” He was identifying with Jesus because he was also under someone else’s authority yet that authority flowed down through him as a commander over 100 soldiers. The Scriptures are silent but I believe this centurion must also have understood that this authority Jesus exercised flowed down from the Father in Heaven.
2. He understood the principles under which Jesus exercised His authority (probably by observing Jesus ministering to the sick, blind, etc.) and thus he possessed great faith. In fact, Jesus makes an astonishing statement to those following Him—that this Roman centurion possessed more faith than anybody Jesus had seen in Israel! In the mind of this Roman centurion, there was no doubt or unbelief. He knew that Jesus had the authority to heal his servant.
3. Unlike the Pharisees and other religious leaders, this centurion was a humble man. Jesus offered to come to his house and heal his servant but he said, “No, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof.”
4. Finally, and this is the most important point, the Roman centurion understood *how* Jesus exercised that authority—by the spoken word! Notice his statement when Jesus said, “I will come and heal him.” He said for Jesus not to come to his

house but to just “speak the word only, and my servant shall (not maybe) be healed.” Wow, what faith; what understanding this man had about Jesus’ authority and how He exercised it.

Now, let’s look at a few other scriptures that will help you understand authority in the earth and why you need to exercise your Kingly Anointing. When Jesus walked the earth as a Man, who had authority over the earth? Most Christians think it was God but it wasn’t. Notice what Satan said to Jesus during the temptation:

“To you I will give all this authority and their glory, for it has been delivered to me, and I give it to whom I will.” ■ Luke 4:6

Who was Satan referring to when he said, “It has been delivered to me?” Who had delivered this authority to him? Adam had! Remember, Adam was originally given authority over the earth. God said in Genesis 1:26, et al, “let them have dominion over ...” and in Genesis 28 to “subdue it,” i.e., the earth. But in the fall, Adam transferred or “delivered” as Satan said that authority to Satan. This is one of the many reasons Jesus is referred to as The Second Adam.

But now let’s follow the scriptures closely and meditate on them and we’ll see that this authority was once again “transferred” or “delivered” back to the Lord God.

“And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, „All power (authority) is given unto me in heaven and in earth.“” (Mt. 28:18)

So, this authority or power and authority over the earth was transferred back to Jesus through His sacrifice at Calvary. Praise the Lord! But Jesus didn’t just stop there. He continued on saying, “Go ye therefore, and teach all nations ...” meaning that He has delegated this authority over not just earth but also Heaven to His Church. Therefore, my brothers and sisters, you are to “go” and exercise your spiritual authority through the spoken word to heal the sick, cast out devils, raise the dead, drive out the works of darkness in your family, community, county, state and country or wherever the Lord sends you. I pray that you have this revelation today and that you will begin to exercise your spiritual authority and your Kingly Anointing by the spoken word.

During the ten years the Lord shut us up in Montana and began to reveal this false church system it was a time of extreme revelation—many, many dreams and visions—often as many as ten a day. During this time most of these had to do with the Holy Spirit revealing this false church; however, I also had scores of visions

and dreams that dealt with the power of our words. Watch your words! They have power. That's why the Bible admonishes us not to talk so much. Jesus Himself said:

“For by your words you will be justified and by your words you will be condemned.” (Mt. 12:37)

Learn to exercise your Kingly Anointing today and make your words count for the Kingdom of God. Praise the Lord.
