A Short Biography for Rev. Dr. Mark Whitley

Rev. Dr. Mark Whitley was most recently the interim pastor at Cordell First United Methodist Church in Cordell, Oklahoma since October 1, 2020.

Mark graduated with his Doctor of Ministry in Spiritual Formation (with honors) in May 2019 from St. Paul School of Theology in Kansas City. The doctoral program was entitled "Prophetic Word and Service." Previously, he completed a three-year program with The Sojourn Institute in Tulsa in 2012 and is a credentialed Spiritual Director. Mark was ordained as a United Methodist elder in full connection in June 2011. He graduated in May 2008 with his Master of Divinity degree (with highest honors) from Phillips Theological Seminary in Tulsa. Mark has two Bachelor of Science Degrees in Biology from McNeese State University in Lake Charles, Louisiana (BS in Medical Technology, 1980, and BS in Pre-Medicine, 1983).

Previously he served as the pastor of Collinsville Meadowcreek United Methodist Church, Verdigris United Methodist Church, the associate pastor at the First United Methodist Church in Bixby, and as pastor of the United Methodist Churches in Waukomis and Verden, OK. Mark was also the chaplain and director of funds development at Epworth Villa from 2003-2005, following his first position in Christian ministry with The Oklahoma United Methodist Foundation as a Planned Giving Officer.

He was a health-care professional for 26 years before entering into the ministry. Mark worked the last eight years as healthcare professional with the American Red Cross at National Head-quarters in 1993-1996 and in Oklahoma City from 1996-2000. The last 14 years he was an organ and tissue donation professional.

He was a volunteer firefighter with the Collinsville Fire Department from 2017-2020 serving as the Department Chaplain. He was selected was one of five Volunteer Firefighters of the Year by The Cherokee Nation in 2020.

Mark has been married to Rev. Susan Whitley for 40 years. Susan is the pastor of the Trinity United Methodist Church in Purcell, OK. Mark and Susan are originally from Lake Charles, Louisiana. Mark and Susan have three adult children, Bryan, Chris, and Caitlin, and four grandchildren. Bryan, Emily and our grandsons Jackson and Bradley in NE Oklahoma City. Chris, Kim and our granddaughters, Adalynn and Olivia live in Norman. Our architect daughter, Caitlin and her husband, Jordan, moved to New York City at Thanksgiving for her new job.

My favorite title is not Dr. Whitley, or Pastor Mark, but Pops! I have been waiting my whole life to be an old coot grandpa, and I finally made it!
