

Classroom behavior expectations and discipline policy

Classroom Behavior:

Students are expected to be kind, caring, courteous and respectful.

The classroom will follow these simple rules:

1. All supplies and property of the church/others will be used appropriately.
2. When someone else is talking, be quiet and listen respectfully.
3. Keep your hands and feet to yourself at all times.

PLEASE go over these rules with your child before classes begin.

Classroom Discipline Policy:

The classroom will operate on a “3 strike system”. When an unacceptable behavior occurs, the student will be instructed what is wrong and how to fix it. If a behavior cannot be modified or changed by the student, the student will receive a “strike”. Should the behavior continue to a third strike, a meeting between the student, parent/guardian, and the teacher will need to take place following Sunday school to address the issue.

Star Wall (Positive Behavior Reinforcement)

Each student has the opportunity to earn “Star Points”. These points will be awarded for positive behaviors in recognition for good choices and character building efforts. Students will receive star cards for kind acts, encouraging words, cooperation, good listening, leadership and patience.

Each month points can be redeemed for prizes/rewards.
