#### Welsh Neck Baptist Association WMU Spring Meeting

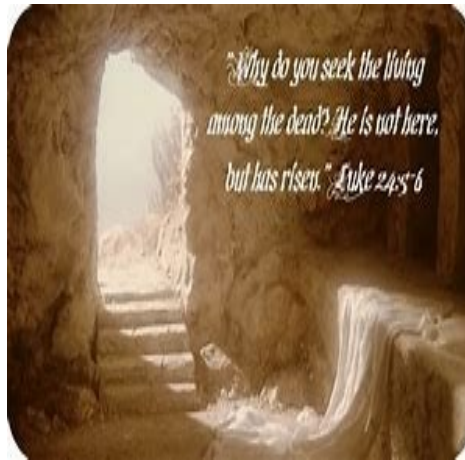

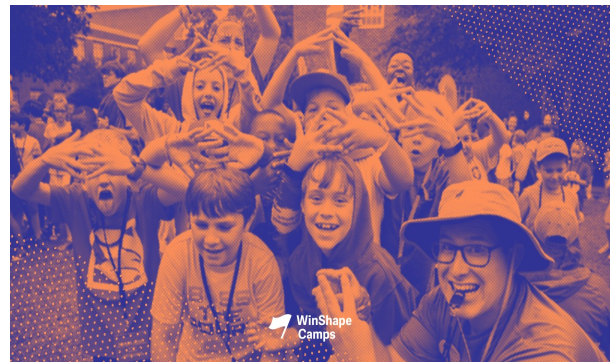
