If you're 70-1/2 or older, you know you have to make Required Minimum **Distributions** 

(RMD) from your IRA, 401K, etc. However, if you make charitable donations from



those funds, the withdrawal will be counted, but you won't have to pay taxes on the money. The withdrawal must be made directly by the fund in order to be tax free. Why not consider making a donation to your church in this way! You'll save tax money, and support PSUMC at the same time—a win-win!
