Like trees, churches grow from the tips up. The new growth always happens on the edges with young, green life. Those tender, growing parts are fed and supported by the rest of the older, well-established parts. Yet even those that have been there the longest are fed by the life-giving energy the new parts bring in.

We have a strong and healthy congregation. It has weathered the storms and lost a few branches, but through careful tending we are now growing again. Our deep roots are ready to support new growth. Already, we have new life flowing through us fed at least in part by the youth and children who are connected to our congregation.

Our leadership has taken the faithful step to more intentionally and directly focus on these new, growing parts of our faith community. Starting next month in August, we will begin a youth and children's ministry. **EVERY SECOND SUNDAY IS CHILDREN'S SUNDAY.** Children's Sunday will have two parts: first, during the worship service, children will meet downstairs with adult leaders working together with a cohesive ministry plan. While we kind of already do this, it hasn't been done very formally or with much advanced preparation. So step one is to simply continue what we are doing, but with more planning and intention.

Secondly, the youth and children will stay after worship for lunch and a time of fellowship led by me in con-junction with other leaders. Each month we will plan to do something different. We've talked about going bowling or hiking or to a movie — regular youth group type stuff. We will always pray and eat (two things our church is very good at!).

One significant help to this end will be a new member of our leadership team. We have agreed to hire a person to be here once a month to plan and lead the Sunday School session downstairs. This person will also coordinate with me and our church members who will help care for the kids. My hope is that whoever we hire will also stay after worship to be involved in the youth activities, as well.

I am very excited about this new ministry. We have many of these important young people here in our church. Youth and children have needs that are not always met in worship or our other fellowship activities. By giving them this special attention, we will faithfully do our part to meet them where they are, bringing them up within the loving fellowship we know in Christ and in this congregation.

If you have children of any age in your family or if you know others who might want to be involved in a group like this, please encourage them to come to THE SECOND SUNDAY of the month to gather together with all of our other youth and children. Consider offering them a ride to and from the church. Perhaps you could help provide lunch for the kids one Sunday. Even if you don't have children, you could still attend to assist others, talk with these kids, and help them make deeper connections to folks in our church.

You are the essential roots and trunk of this tree. These new, growing children will need your support and steadiness. Then, as their part, they will bring new life and energy to our community. As a healthy tree, as a thriving church, we will continue to bear fruit for the Kingdom of God together.

I'm very excited about this. I hope you are, too.




