

Payable-On-Death Designation (POD)

You can perpetuate your legacy and potentially avoid probate as it relates to bank accounts, government bonds, securities, CD's, and individual retirement accounts by creating a payable-on-death designation.

To do so, you name Canfield Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) on the ownership document (such as the registration card for a bank account or CD beneficiary form) to inherit the asset at your death.

You retain control of your property while you are alive, and can change the beneficiary designation at any time. At your death, the property is transferred directly to Canfield Christian Church (Disciples of Christ).

Transfer on Death Designation (TOD)

Similar to a POD designation, a Transfer on Death designation naming Canfield Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) permits Canfield Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) to receive the named assets at the time of your death.

This designation lets the account or security owner to specify what percentage of the asset Canfield Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) will receive.

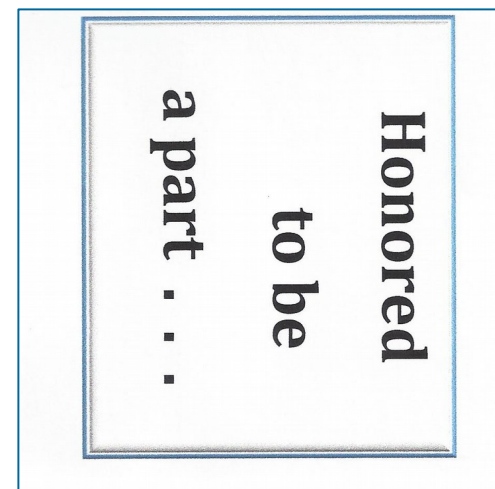
