As the Trumansburg United Methodist Church, in the spirit of Christ's teachings, we:

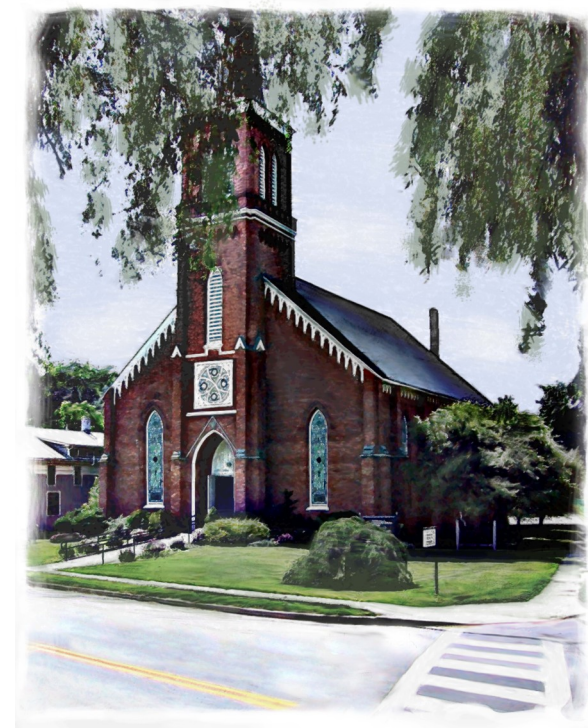
- 1) Learn and explore the wonders and challenges of life;

Our building houses the community Food Pantry and is the center of numerous civic and community organizational activities. Maintaining our building serves Christ's Church and the Trumansburg Community in innumerable ways. We exist to worship God and to serve God's people. The church building helps us do God's work.



Since its dedication in 1857, our church building has been a blessing. How many lives have been touched by the ministries of our church? How many weddings? 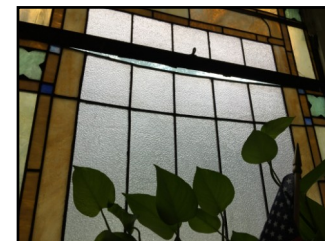
