If you are new to the area and seeking Christian fellowship, we hope you will consider making this your church home.

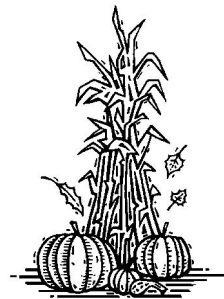
