I know many of you have been seen countless statements, many posts on Facebook, Instagram, and other news sources regarding the proposed Protocol Document on Reconciliation and Separation. The national and local media outlets have picked up the story with their own sensational headlines: "The United Methodist Church Splits."

Be aware that this agreement is a **proposal** to the General Conference. It was created by 16 individuals (8 bishops and 8 representatives from various groups) who acted on their own. The General Conference will have to first act to receive this proposal since it did not come through the normal cycle.

It may not be accepted at all which makes the news stories very misleading. This proposal must still be approved by the General Conference before anything changes or any vote will take place. Please remember that no proposal is Disciplinary law until it is voted on and approved by General conference. These with delegates from around the world will meet in May of this year.
