July 19-25 is National Natural Family Planning Awareness Week! Natural Family Planning (NFP) is authentic family planning. It can be used to both achieve and to postpone a pregnancy. NFP makes use of periodic abstinence in order to space births or to limit the number of children when there is a serious reason to do so. This practice fosters in couples an attitude of respect and wonder in the face of human life, which is sacred. It also fosters profound respect for one's spouse, which is necessary for authentic intimacy. Find out more about what Natural Family Planning can do for your marriage by visiting www.fargodiocese.org/nfp. While there, check out the list of instructors near you! Please note, the nearest instructors are in Devils Lake and Rock Lake. Have you ever thought about being an NFP instructor? If so, please prayerfully consider whether God may be calling you to serve in this way.

COVID-19: At Mass – Please consider wearing a cloth face covering - we are seeing an increase of cases in the state and should try to avoid transmitting the virus at Mass; Holy Communion may be received either on the hand or tongue; please practice physical distancing; there will be music at Mass now, but only the cantor will sing; everyone is still dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass but if you are in good health and comfortable with coming, please do! *Outside of Mass:* parish groups may meet but should observe physical distancing. If you are unsure whether or not a given parish activity is possible at this time, please discuss with Fr. Kraemer.
