**From the Pastor's Desk**  
**Congratulations to Deacon Brewer** who was ordained on October 31 by Bishop Folda! He will now be serving the parishes of Saints Peter and Paul and St. Cecilia as a deacon.

**Indulgence for the Dead:** A plenary indulgence is the complete remission of the temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences are normally obtained for oneself, but during November, the Church offers two ways of obtaining a plenary indulgence for the souls in Purgatory.

The first way to get the indulgence is to visit a cemetery and pray for the dead on any days, up to a total of 8 times, during the month of November. (Normally it is any and each day from Nov. 1-8, but this year the Vatican extended it any 8 days in November). The second way church on any day in the month of November and recite the Our Father and the Creed. (Normally one must do this on Nov. 2, but this year the Vatican has extended it). The Vatican also said that, because of the health emergency, the elderly, the sick, and others who cannot leave the house for serious reasons can participate in the indulgences from home by reciting prayers for the deceased before an image of Jesus or the Virgin Mary. Among the various prayers that are recommended are the Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, meditating on various Gospel passages, or completing a work of mercy by offering to God the suffering and discomforts of one's own life.

Both indulgences must include the three ordinary conditions (Sacramental Confession, reception of Holy Communion, and praying an Our Father and Hail Mary for the Pope) within about 20 days before or after. During this month you can actually receive 9 indulgences for the souls in purgatory. A single sacramental confession suffices for multiple indulgences, but prayer for the Holy Father and reception of Holy Communion must accompany each indulgence.

**Confessions:** the Vatican encourages priests this month to make confession more available. I will add an hour of confessions on Thursday Nov. 12 & 19 between 7-8pm in Velva.

**Covid-19: McHenry County is at 'high risk' for the transmission of Covid-19. Please diligently observe these safety measures:** *At Mass* - Practice physical distancing and wear a cloth face covering; Holy Communion may be received either on the hand or tongue; no congregational singing; the dispensation from Sunday obligation is still in effect; those at high-risk or who care for high-risk individuals may consider taking advantage of this dispensation; please spread yourselves out across the different Mass times so as to not overfill the Church. *Outside of Mass:* Parish groups (council meetings, bible studies, etc.,) may meet, but must practice physical distancing, and when distancing is not possible, use face coverings. *Religious Education:* In person classes will continue as of now; all teachers and students are required to wear cloth face coverings at all times.
