Week 2: The Good Samaritan Luke 10:25-37

Jesus told a man to love God and love his neighbor. The man asked, "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus told a story to answer him. "A man was walking down the road. Robbers hurt him and took all he had. They left the hurt man lying beside the road. "Two different men came down the road. They saw the hurt man, but moved to the other side of the road. "Then a Samaritan saw the hurt man. The Samaritan helped the man. He bandaged him. He took the hurt man to an inn and took care of him. The next day the kind man gave the owner of the inn money to take care of the hurt man until he was well." After the story Jesus asked, "Which of the three men treated the hurt man like a neighbor?" The man said, "The one who helped the hurt man." Jesus said, "Go and help others like the kind man did."

LIVE IT OUT

In our second lesson for the month of March, we are continuing to learn about God's DESIGN for people. God DESIGNED people in His image for His Kingdom purposes. Review the story from Sunday with your preschooler. Ask your child: what does it mean to love the Lord your God and love others? Then ask them: How do you know that I love you? After they answer talk about the story by discussing with them that loving someone involves both what you say and how you treat them. Together continue exploring loving others through this activity: Grab a sheet of paper and a box of band aids. At the top of the paper write: Love God and Love Others. Ask your child how they can help someone who is hurting. Help them think of a few different ways, and for each idea, let them stick the band aid on the paper, while you write what they said next to the band aid. Hang the paper on your fridge this week as a reminder to love God and love others.



LIVE IT OUT

As your child continues to mature and grow up they are learning the true lessons of loving God and loving others through peers, siblings, church and most importantly through you as their parents. In what ways do you see that your child is showing their love for God and for others. List the ways on a sheet of paper and allow for a special time where you share with your child the ways you have seen God developing them into the young lady or man that He wants them to be. Ask them if they remember the Bible Fellowship lesson from Sunday. Then discuss why loving others is more than just telling someone you love them, but it is also showing them. Read over the scripture passage from Sunday together. Then as a family think of someone you know in need: physically, emotionally, or monetarily. Show love to that person as a family by helping them through giving your time, money or writing them an encouraging note.
