

Week 1: God Made Day, Night, Land, and Plants Genesis 1:1-19

In the beginning, God created the world. Everything was dark. God said, "Let there be light!" Suddenly the light began to shine. Now there was both light and darkness. God called the light day and the darkness night. This was the first day. On the second day, God created a huge space above the earth. He called the huge space sky. On day three, God made dry land. He gathered water into oceans, rivers, and lakes. God made plants and trees to grow on the earth. He created the plants and trees so that each kind of plant would have its own kind of seed. Next, God made lights to separate the day from the night. He made the sun to shine during the day and the moon and stars to shine at night. This was the fourth day. God saw that all He had created was good.

LIVE IT OUT

God made the world! Over the next month we are going to learn about creation! God created day, night, land and plants! Play peek-a-boo with your child. Tell them God made day and night! Tell them, when my hands cover my eyes it's dark like night, and when I take my hands away it is light like daytime! Another day this week take a nature walk with your child as you retell the the story. Explain to your child that the very ground you are walking on, God made! The plants you are looking at, God made those too! Take time to appreciate all that God has made and consider the fact that He is the Great Designer.
