

## Week 5: Noah Worked Hard Genesis 6:9-8:22

Noah was a good man who loved God. One day God told Noah to build a big boat called an ark. God told Noah how to build the boat. God explained to Noah that it was going to rain for many days. He told Noah to take two of every kind of animal into the ark. God reminded Noah to take food for his family and the animals. Noah worked hard. He did everything God told him to do. The rain came down for forty days and forty nights, but Noah and his family were safe inside the boat. When the rain finally stopped, Noah waited for the water to dry up. ## LIVE IT OUT

God provided for Noah and his family as they were rescued from the flood. Noah obeyed God by building a giant boat that protected his family and pairs of all of the animals. Make a boat with your child, and as you create together, thank God for His creation!

### Make a Boat

- Cut up pool noodle
- Foam Sheets
- Straws
- Hole Punch & scissors



Cut the noodle into 2 in. wide rings and set aside. Use the foam sheet to cut making a triangle sail for the boat. Then use the hole punch to make two holes in the foam sheet, one at the top and one at the bottom. Slide the straw through the holes of the foam triangle. Take your scissors and make a hole in the pool noodle ring for the straw to attach into. Let your preschooler try out their new boat in water!

## LIVE IT OUT

He, his family, and two of every kind of animal were saved from the flood that covered the whole earth! When Noah got off of the ark, guess what he did? (He praised God!) We can praise God too for many reasons! As a family think of a few ways that you can praise God this week. Begin by talking to God and telling Him how great He is. Then, later this week, choose a time to intentionally sing a song of worship to God as a family.
