

COMMUNICATION

Greetings everyone. I'm convinced that the most important word in human language is the word *communication*. And for me, this is all about love.

The Greatest Commandment is as follows:

Jesus said,

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. Matthew 22:37-40

The meeting was opened with devotions and prayer by Pastor Burkhalter.

Corporate officer elections were held. The following officers were chosen:

Council minutes, financial reports and staff reports were reviewed and approved.

Facility Use Requests

Laura Mitchell has requested use of the church facilities for four occasions. There was discussion of using the facilities during the COVID pandemic. A suggestion was made to follow the county guidelines for safe use. Small group would be allowed if the "light" is yellow or green. Large groups such as the Family Promise fundraiser would require a green light. This is the guide schools will be using for the fall. David Hrivnak moved/ Jim Louthan seconded. Motion passed with one abstention. An action item was documented to prepare a guideline draft document in keeping with the school system plan, to obtain Council approval, and to share the document with the congregation.

Old Business:

The unity service scheduled for August has been cancelled at the suggestion of area ministers. Holy Trinity will notify area churches that we would welcome the opportunity to host this service at a later date.

Continuing on Sundays 10:00 AM

Join us in the parking lot for worship this week. The service will begin at 10AM and will last about 30 minutes. Then, for those who wish to participate, 'contactless' drive thru communion will be offered.



As you approach the church, tune your FM radio to 99.7. Beginning about 9:45AM there will be a broadcast with more detailed instructions on parking, the service, the communion, etc. That information will repeat until time for the ser-

vice. Basically park in the main lot, facing the building, but please do not park in the few spaces directly along the sidewalk by the sign. You may also park in the grassy lot across Broad Street from the sign.





The service will be heard on that same frequency (99.7) beginning at 10AM. At the conclusion, Holy Communion will be offered, with cars routed from the Broad Street entrance by the sign toward the playground. Stop by the Gathering Room doors and Pastor will extend a tray to the driver with enough communion (wafers and wine in individual glasses) for each person in the car. The driver will distrib-

ute communion to passengers. Pastor will be wearing gloves and mask,

and the napkin under the elements will be discarded each time in case the communicant touches the napkin. When finished communing, turn right toward the Urology building and exit by that building. Music will be playing on our station throughout the Holy Communion process.

With drive-thru Holy Communion after brief service.




Altar flowers enhance the beauty of the worship


