

Opportunity for Housing Purchase

Last Sunday the deacons, finance committee, properties committee and trustees met after church to consider an opportunity to purchase a home for our youth ministry staff. We are looking at a 2013 Solitaire 18 x 80 home. It is currently owned by the Torrance family. The price is \$48,000 including porches and skirting. There will be additional cost of around \$10,000 to move and get it all set up. We will be seeking city approval to place the home on the NE corner of 7th and Clay, or just south of our bus barn. That property was donated to the church by the Leach family. The home is three bed rooms and two baths. It has a large open kitchen, dinning and family room. The master bed room has a large walk in closet. It is approximately 1360 square feet. That is less than \$45 a square foot. You will be able to receive a hand out Sunday morning or you can come by the office. After touring the home, the deacons and committee members unanimously agreed to recommend the purchase of the home. The group voted to bring this opportunity before the church this coming Sunday in a special called business meeting immediately following morning worship. The personnel committee also believes that our search for a youth minister will be greatly aided by having a very nice home like this to show.
