Scripture Reading: Romans 6:9, "We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again, death has no dominion over Him."

Romans 10:9-10, "That if you shall confess with your mouth and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart man believes unto righteous, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation."

Psalm 150:61, "Let everything that hath breath praise the Lord. Praise Ye the Lord."

Acts 16:25, "And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them."

Reflection: We have discussed numerous times how our words have power. The words and attitude that comes from our mouth can bring people to Christ or away from Christ. How are you using your words? Are you Praising God for all He has done for you, or are you complaining about temporary circumstances? Today, you will think of the ways God has blessed you. Make a list of those blessings. Pray over those blessing and thank God for them. Remember in October when I asked, "What if God only let you keep what you thanked Him for yesterday?" Same goes today. This is between you and God. Extended Activities

Make Easter Buns: Dip marshmallows in melted butter and cinnamon and sugar mixture. Wrap crescent roll around marshmallow and bake at 350 for about 8-12 minutes. You will be in for a surprise when you bite into these!

Make Easter Story Trail Mix: Pretzels represents the cross, (Colossians 2:24); Craisins or raisins represents Jesus' blood (Ephesians 1:7); Round cracker- the stone that was rolled away (Luke 24:2); Goldfish crackers reminds us to be fishers of men (Matthew 2:14) M&M reminds us God is good all the time (Psalm 34:8); White Marshmallow shows our sins are washed away as white as snow. (I John)
