**Extended Activity-** Make Homemade Hand Sanitizer- Mix 2/3 cup rubbing alcohol, 1/3 cup aloe vera gel, a few drops of essential oils such as peppermint, vanilla, citrus, thives, or lavender all in a bowl. Use a funnel to pour into a bottle.

Make Play Dough- Mix 2 cups corn starch and 1 cup baby lotion into bowl. Separate into smaller bowls and add food coloring and essential oils if you want to have several colors and smells. This playdough is super soft.
