REFLECTION

From All the Good, a Wesleyan Way of Christmas

"When the biblical texts describe God as good, this describes God's actions as well as God's character. Whether in the midst of great joy and celebration or in the midst of deep tragedy, injustice and natural disasters, *God is good because God's love is steadfast.* As the liturgical refrain exclaims this biblical theme:

'God is good all the time All the time, God is good.'

By pondering God's goodness through the Christmas narrative, we are invited to reflect on and participate in Christian practices, or good works, in response to God's goodness. These practices resemble those encouraged by disciples throughout Christian tradition as well as by the founder of the early Methodist movement, John Wesley."

Loving God, Advent is a time to prepare to receive your presence in the birth of Jesus Christ, who embodies your love for all creation. Help us to respond to your amazing gift by loving you and loving others. Remind us what it means to practice Advent and participate in your love and grace using John Wesley's example. Amen




Jesus' disciples saw the large stones of the temple.




