

These are well known Psalms and Old Testament lessons, but this is not an all inclusive list, other verses can be requested in consultation with the pastor officiating at the memorial service. The most familiar part of the verses have been loosely paraphrased for your recognition. **Please refer to a Bible in the translation you prefer to check the whole passage and wording before selecting a verse.**

Psalm 103:1-5	Bless the Lord O my soul and all that is within me bless his holy name...
Psalm 103:8-12	The Lord is compassionate...slow to anger and abounding in love
Psalm 103:15-18	Man's day is like the lilies of the field...but the Lord's mercy is from age to age.
