PASTOR TO PEOPLE

"Happy New Year!"

I know what you're thinking; my greeting is a month early. That's true if we're looking at a calendar for 2008. However, if we are looking at the calendar of the Christian year, Sunday, December 2nd begins a new year as the First Sunday of Advent. The four weeks of Advent are a season of preparation for Christmas, as the Church moves from hope to joy. As described in *The United Methodist Book of Worship*, "The season proclaims the comings of Christ – whose birth we prepare to celebrate once again, who comes continually in Word and Spirit, and whose return in final victory we anticipate." In remembering and acknowledging that the "the Word became flesh and dwelt among us" (John 1:14), the Church proclaims and lives the message that Jesus Christ is Savior and Lord.

Poteau UMC has for many years helped prepare the entire community for the celebration of the Christ Child with its Living Nativity scene. Also, individuals and groups within the congregation participate in Angel Tree or similar ministries. As children's voices, ringing hand bells, the lighting of candles, are added to the worship service, our corporate worship of God is focused on preparation for the coming of Christ.

And so as we join together this Advent season, I offer this prayer from the *Book of Worship* for your usage:

Ever present God, you taught us that the night is far spent and the day is at hand. Grant that we may ever be found watching for the coming of your Son. Save us from undue love of the world, that we may wait with patient hope for the day of the Lord, and so abide in him, that when he shall appear, we may not be ashamed; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

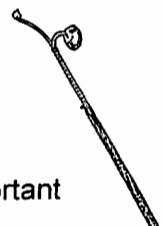
