From the Pastor . . .

Dear Family of God at St. Thomas & Supporters,

I pray this December article in our monthly Steeple Bell newsletter finds you and your family healthy and staying safe re the Covid virus. Well, I can hardly believe we are almost in the

month of December and in about five weeks we will be celebrating the New Year of 2021. Where did the year go?

Meantime, we celebrate Thanksgiving tomorrow (this past week by the time you read this) and though we will all do our best to enjoy a festive meal of turkey with all the trimmings or another favorite meal either in our own home or away and will do our best to be thankful people, we can't deny or forget that the shadow of the Covid virus is present with us causing us to feel anxious and uneasy at times.

- Finances: September Finances reviewed. Scott moved to accept. Janet seconded. Unanimously approved.
- Janet moved to approve October financial report. Gary seconded. Unanimously approved.
- Scrip: Nan Morrish, Sue Eory and Gary McWhorter have helped in the past. We are looking for someone to run the scrip program.
- Need to talk with the Outreach Committee about what to do with the Thrift Shop account.
- Pledges are coming in slowly. We need to get everyone's pledge so we can make a budget
- Proposed budget tabled until December when more data will be available.

October Minutes: Scott moved to accept minutes as amended. Sherry seconded. Unanimously approved.

#### **New Business**

- Rev. Shirley is working on her health insurance application. Scott moves we continue with the top tier of insurance for Rev. Shirley. Peter seconded. Unanimously approved.
- January 24<sup>th</sup> proposed for annual meeting. We are going to plan to hold the meeting in the church for social distancing. If circumstances change, we will be prepared to hold the meeting on Zoom.
- Capacity of the Church for Christmas Eve Service: We will ask people to make reservations for the service so we
  can plan our social. Can Helping Hands or Outreach help with calling members to get reservations for Christmas
  Eve. Proposal is to have the service Christmas Eve in the afternoon before it gets dark to make it safe for everyone
  who avoids driving at night.
