This will be a short gathering with instrumental music, scripture and communion. At the end of worship, we will gather outside to sing Silent Night. We will not be passing out candles this year, but we do encourage you to bring your own light source like a phone or small flashlight. Pre-packaged communion elements are available, but you can also bring your own. Masks and distancing are required during our worship, both inside and out.

A worship video will also be available on YouTube for people who would like to worship before 7:00 p.m.

If you only want to join us for the outside portion of singing Silent Night, we welcome you to gather with us at the close of worship. You can keep track of when we are getting close to coming out by checking the live stream on your phone.

In order for us to best prepare and to ensure we stay within our expectations for safety, we ask that you Make A Reservation to attend the 7:00 PM worship. We will do our best to accommodate everyone, but we can't squeeze in like we used to. We will be seating people in alternate areas of our building (outside the sanctuary) that have TVs which will allow people to participate.



During our Christmas Eve Service the entire offering will go towards the "Christ Child Offering." Offering plates will be made available near the entrance of the sanctuary for you to drop your offering in. Please make checks out to First Christian Church. If you are giving cash and want it counted on your "statement of giving", please use an envelope and put your name on it. We have traditionally encouraged individuals to consider giving as much to this offering as they would spend on a gift for a family member. Our Outreach Committee is designating 50% of the total offering to PET kids mobility carts and 50% to the Food Pantry for the Buddy Pack Program. If you do not plan to attend worship on Christmas Eve and would like to contribute to the Christ Child offering, you can use a standard offering envelope at any time and mark it "Christ Child." Important Tax Information

Contributions to the church must be delivered on or before December 31 in order to claim a charitable contribution deduction for 2020. Checks that are received the first Sunday (Jan 3rd) in 2021 WILL NOT qualify for a charitable contribution deduction in 2020, even if the check is pre-dated or was actually written in 2020. However, checks that are written, mailed and postmarked in 2020 will be deductible in 2020 even though they are not received at the church until 2021.
