## Grace Notes....

Lent begins on Wednesday. I know that sentence made those of you who have heard that word before go—"o—I need to find something to give up for Lent." I also know that for those who haven't heard the word "Lent" wondered why the church is going to spend so much time considering the stuff that gathers in our belly buttons! So just what is "Lent?" Why is it important? What am I supposed to do with it?

To begin with I always say Lent is a time for Christians everywhere to reflect on their own lives, repent of their own sins and refocus their eyes on the redemptive life of Jesus.

My friend Doug Skinner in his post today talks about the season of Lent this way

"Above the door of my office at Northway I kept a picture of the disciples sound asleep in the Garden of Gethsemane. It was the very last thing that I would see each Sunday morning as I headed out of my office for the sanctuary to preach. I put it there to remind me of what it was that I was up against, and of what it is that I am so prone to myself. We all get tired and distracted. We all become unfocused and can be completely unaware. We're not always as disciplined and dialed in as we should be. We all sleep through God moments and movements as we "slouch towards Jerusalem."

Lent begins this week, on Wednesday - Ash Wednesday. Contrary to what you might have heard, Lent is not about giving something up. In fact, it trivializes the whole spiritual intention of Lent to make it about ice cream or caffeine, another glass of wine or how much screen time you have each day. It may do you some good to get a better handle on some of these things in your life, but that's not what Lent is for. Lent is for getting serious about God. Lent is about paying better attention to what it is that God is doing in the world and in our lives. Lent is a spiritual wakeup call to keep us from being asleep in the light."

As we begin this season of Lent—may we truly be awakened to what God is doing in our lives, the lives of our loved ones and the ones we have yet to love!






