

This week's word: *GATE*

This week we hear from Jesus again from John 10 - Verses 1-10 - where he announces I AM the GATE. Some translations use the word DOOR. The whole statement is clear:

"Very truly I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep. ⁸ All who have come before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep have not listened to them. ⁹ I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. ^[a] They will come in and go out, and find pasture. ¹⁰ The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. John 10:7-10



What is this GATE - that Jesus compares himself to? You have to read it all to get it. The answer - Jesus is the GATE or door to ABUNDANT life. A Full Life. A Complete life. ALL of life.

We spend so much time in this world working on creating and collecting "more." But Jesus promises more than more. He promises ALL - He promises completeness, fullness, abundance. But there is a catch. We have to do it His way. We have to come in THROUGH Him - not around him, not by him, not just acknowledging him. Our fullness, our completeness depends on our hearing and responding to his voice and coming fully into his presence and following Him. Only then will we find all that He has promised.

Why?




