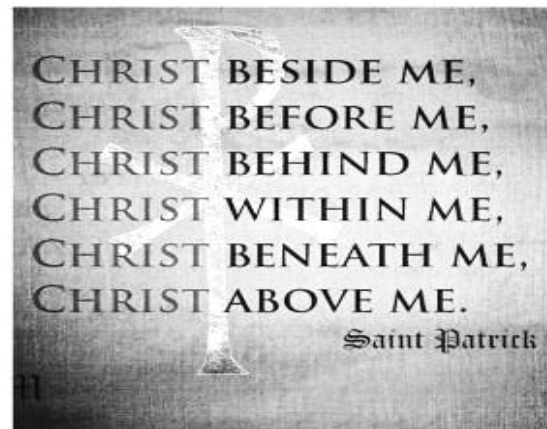
Scripture: John 2:13-22 Jesus clears out the temple of the people who are selling and changing money.

 - e. Look into replacing the A/C units, get quotes (existing units are 30+ years old) Scott from King Air has set up a Representative to see what can be done on a split system. Will be at the building at 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday if anyone wants to hear and ask questions.
 - f. Received a quote to fix cracks, caulk, prep, prime & paint all the classrooms (all but drop ceilings) - \$2,502.50 by J&A Builders

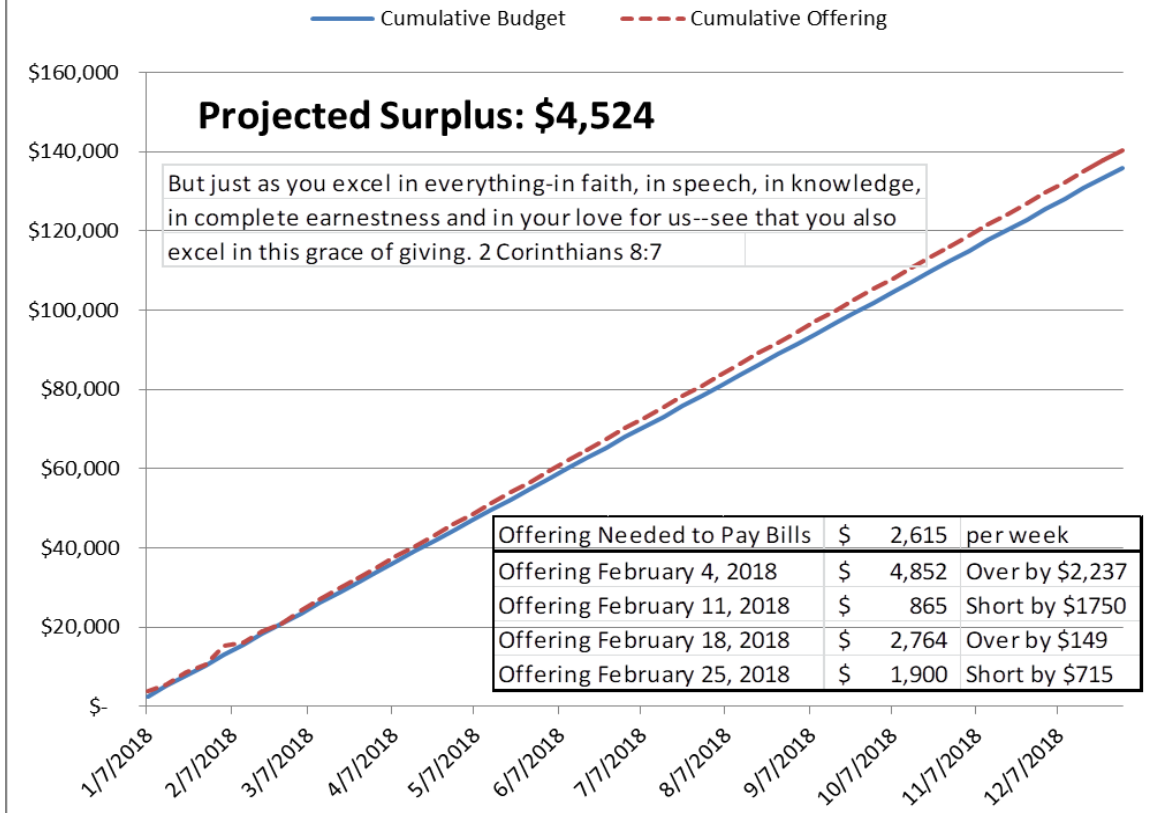
1. Old Business
