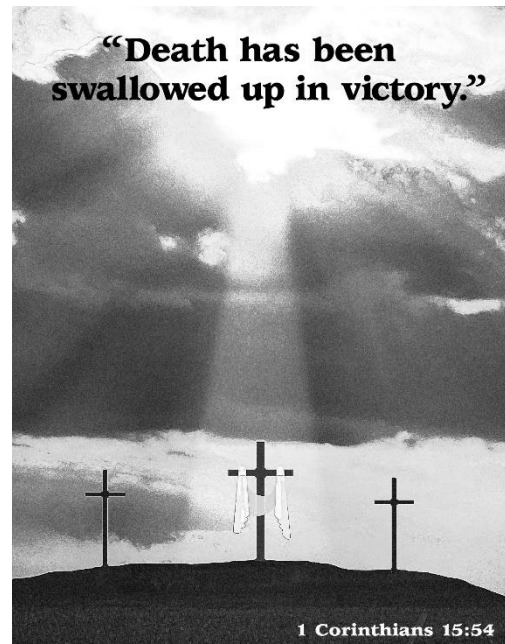

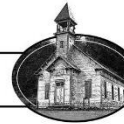

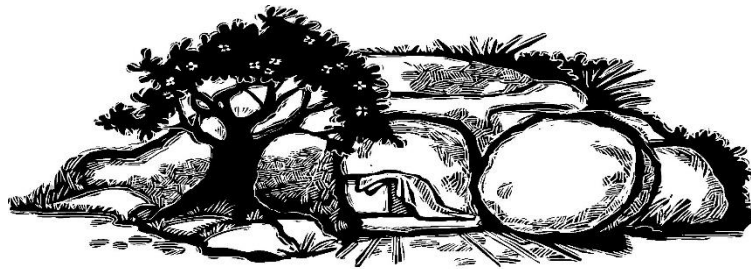

Meeting next Sunday, 12 noon

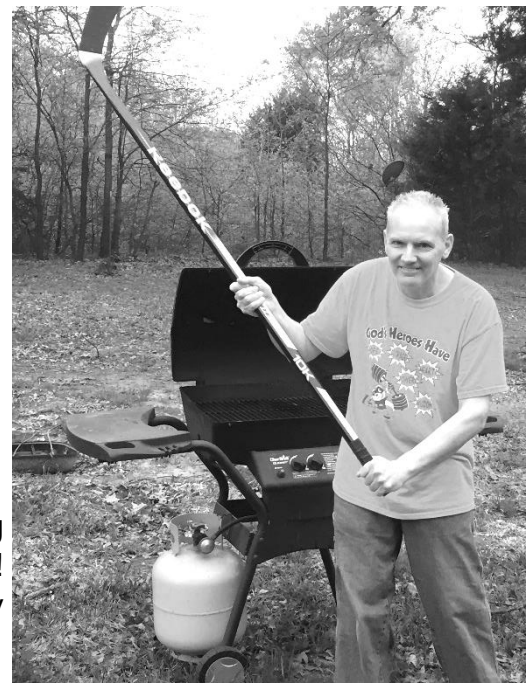

TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES

March 26, 2018

1. Educational Building Renovations
 - a. Termite Pest Control – Wesley Killian recommended Jim Vail to treat for termites.
 - b. A/C Units:
 - i. Approved approx. \$10,000 to cover purchasing and installing two A/C units
 - ii. Appointed a committee to pick best A/C units from list submitted by Henry Reed
 - c. Interior work (repairs, paint, etc.) – tabled until other work completed
 - d. Exterior work:
 - i. Discussion about drainage on South side (towards Sanctuary) – possible French drain, getting bids for this work
 - ii. Siding and underpinning discussion – will gather more info about just replacing the damaged siding versus all new siding
