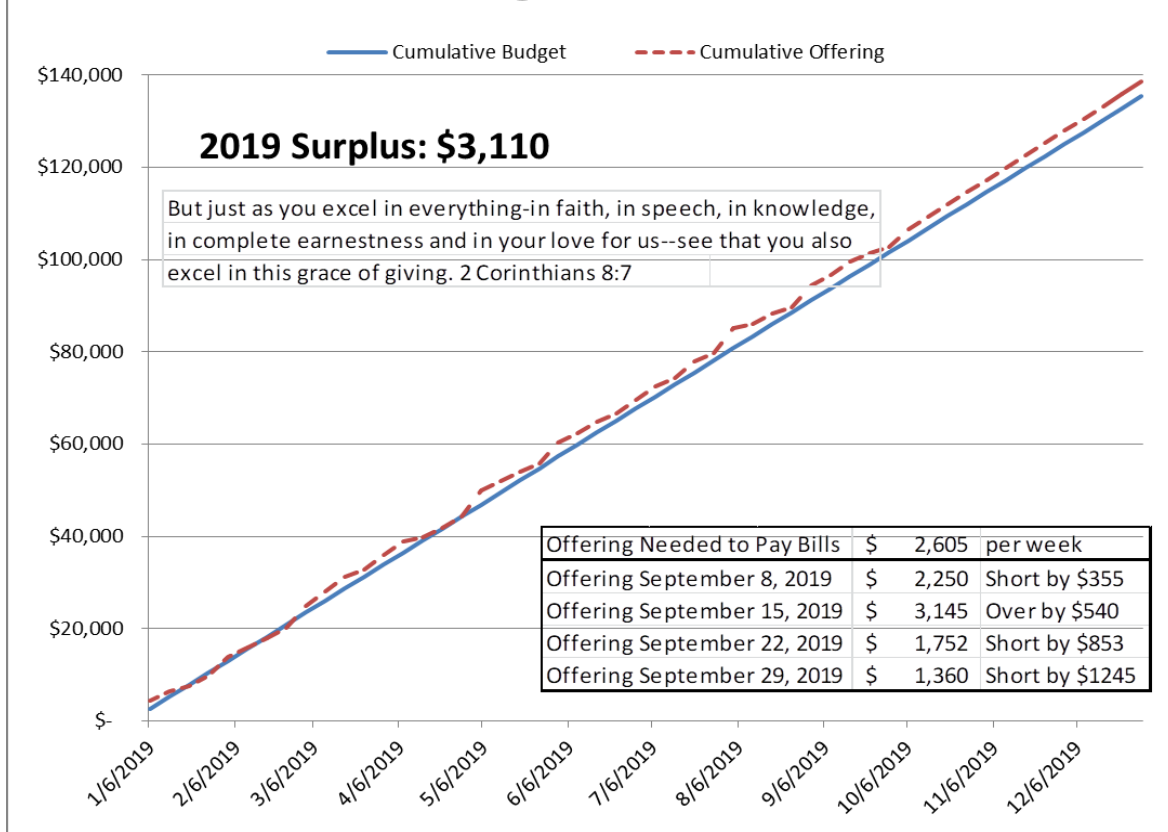
Tickets are now available from Kathy Boltin. Grab a bunch and sell them around town! And send your items list to becca10000@aol.com as soon as you can.
