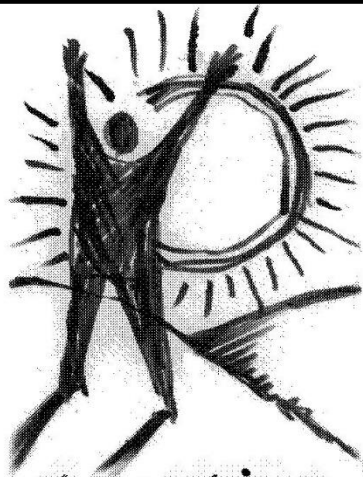

We will be starting off the new year with TWO new Bible Study classes. Jackie Winton will be leading a Ladies Bible Study, beginning on



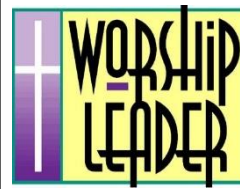
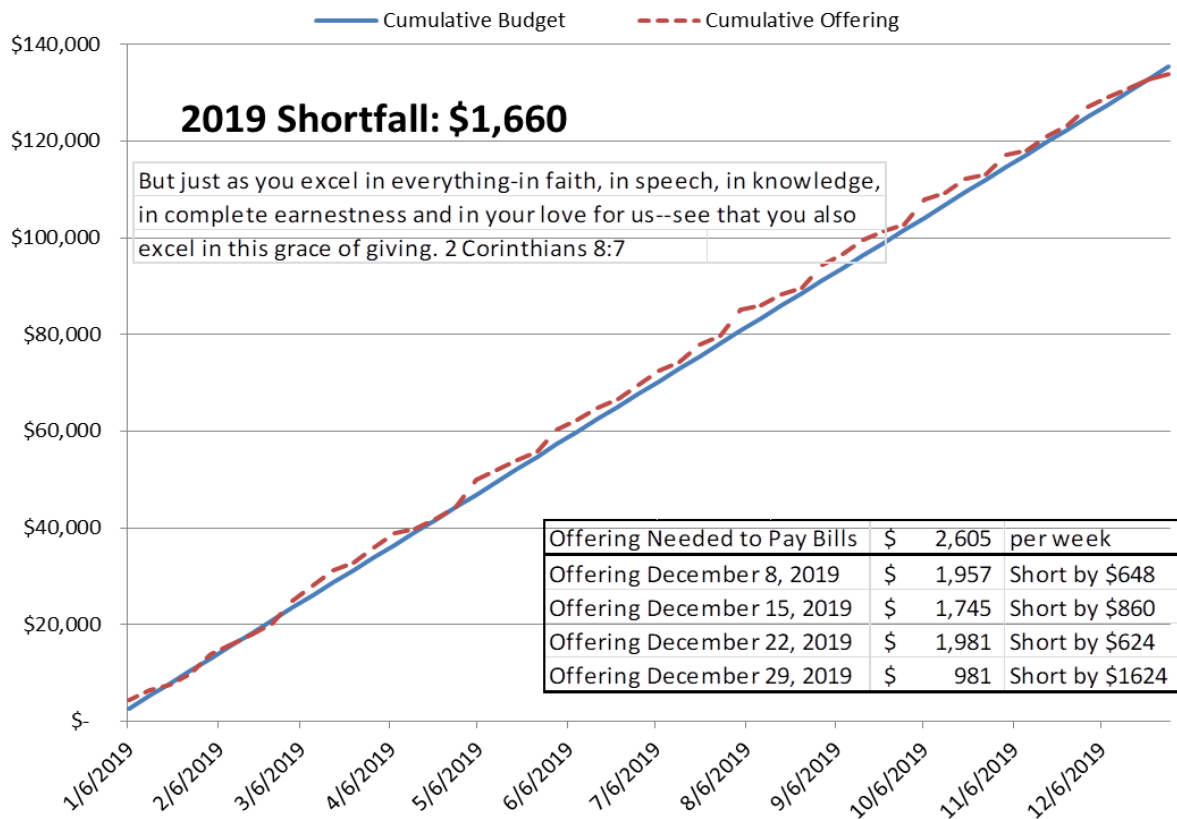
