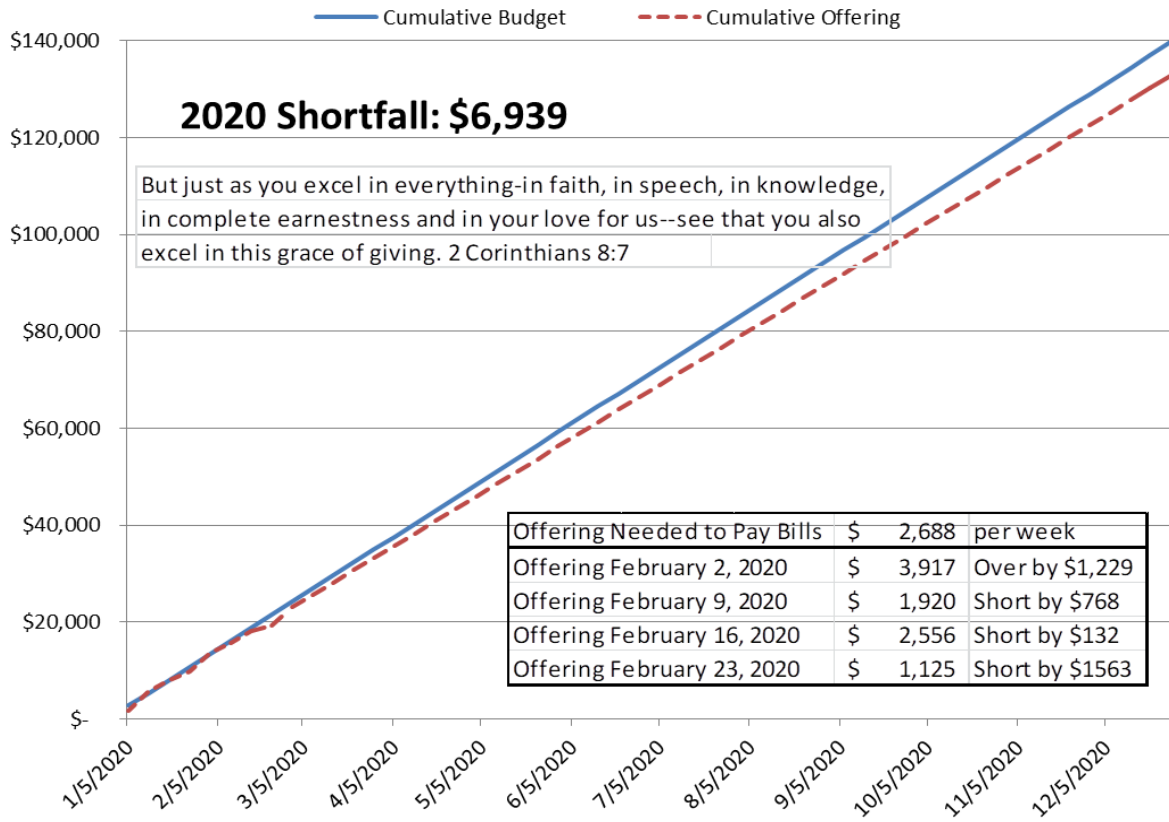

Church Budget at 2/23/20



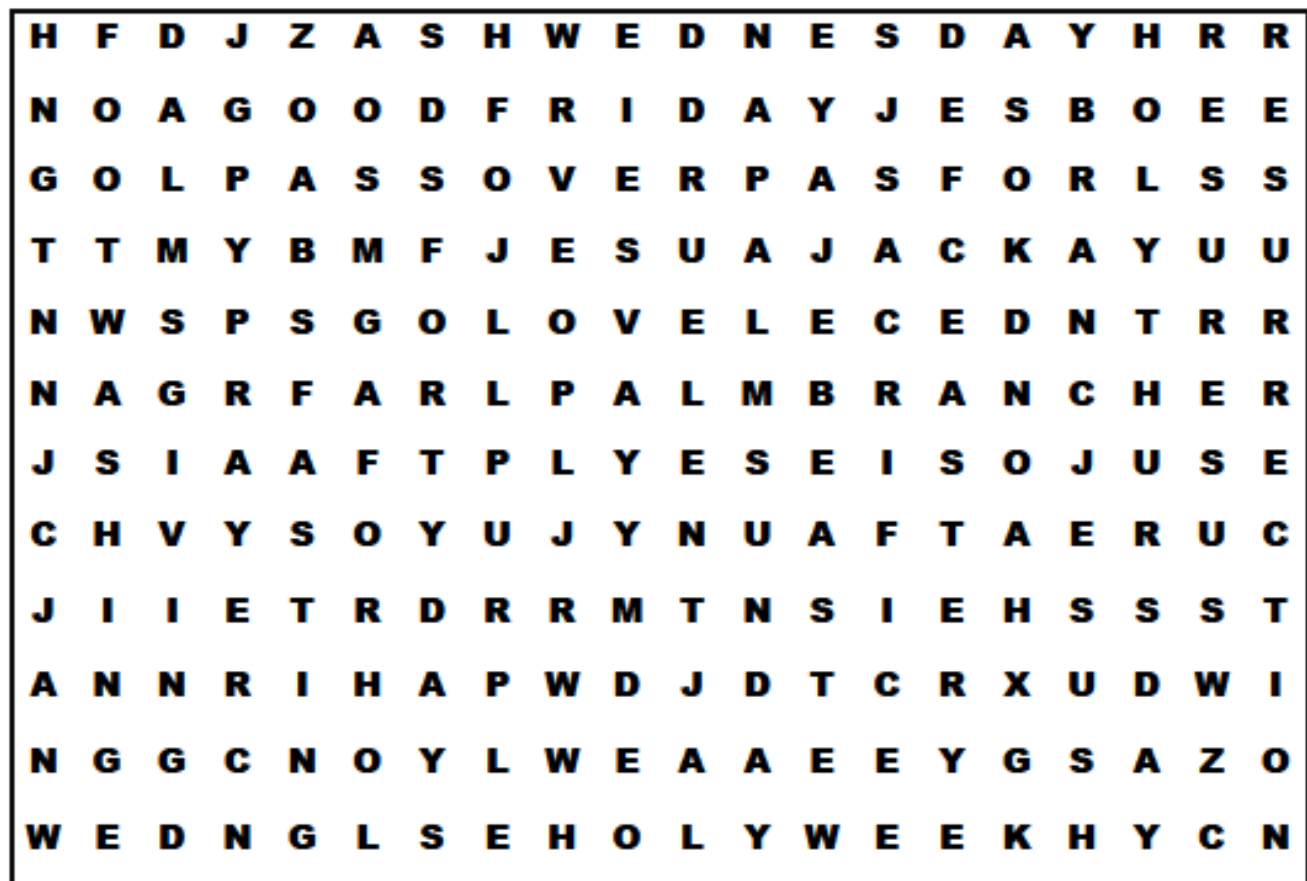
CHL Class at CMUMC!
