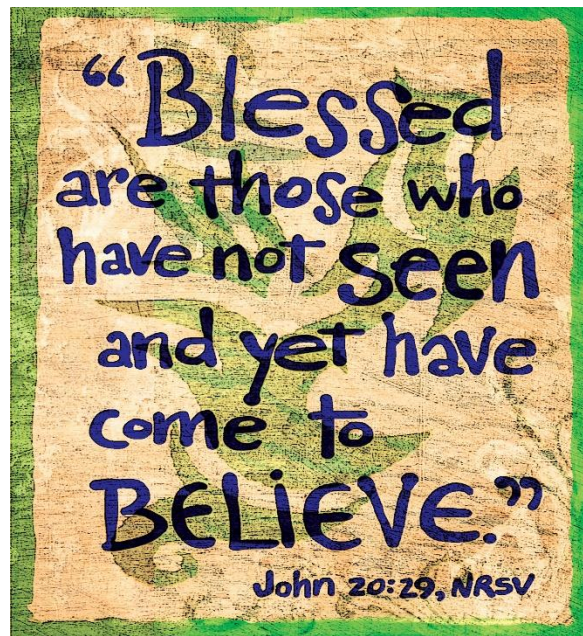

Here's another easy bread recipe that DOESN'T require yeast, and it is delicious. In a large bowl, mix 3 cups of self-rising flour (must be self-rising), ½ cup of sugar and one 12 oz. can or bottle of dark beer (Shiner Bock works well). There's no need to knead! 😊 Put the mixture into a greased loaf pan and bake in a preheated 350 degree oven for 45 minutes. For extra goodness, pour a ¼ cup of melted butter over the top of the loaf after it has baked for 35 minutes, then bake for 10 more minutes. So good!

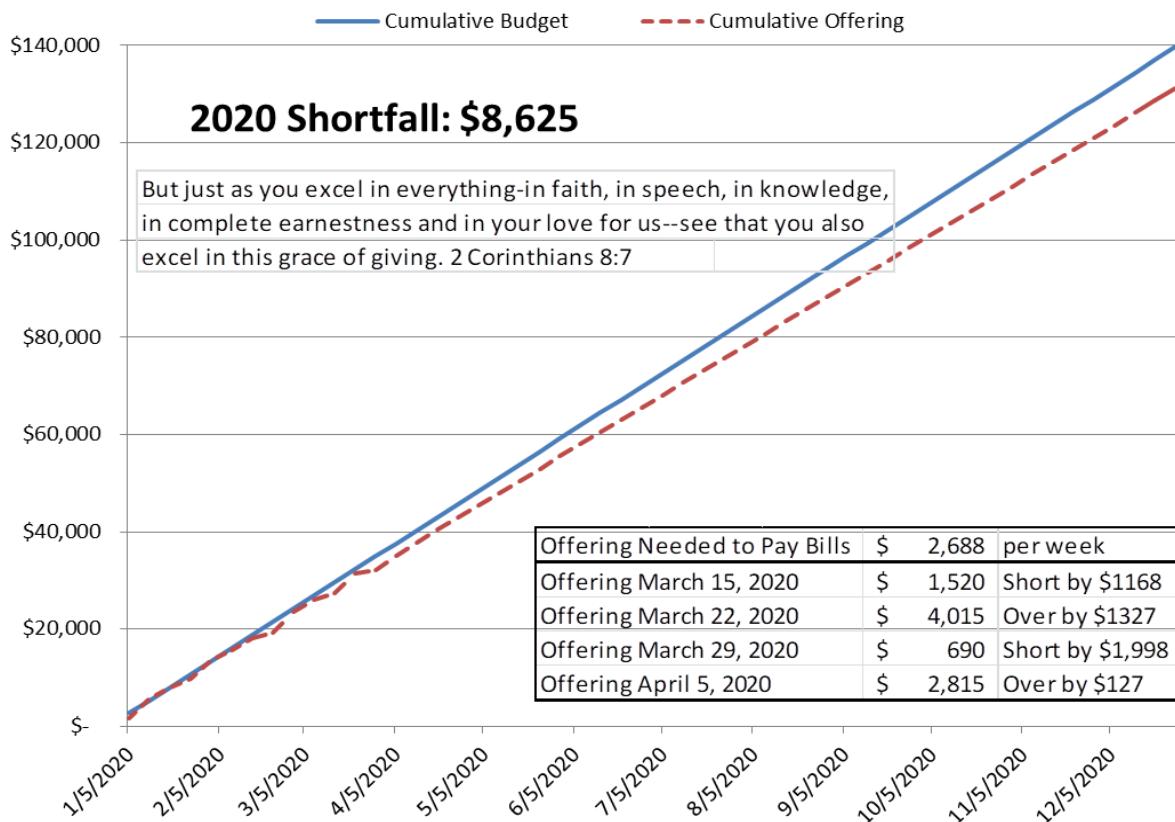
