From the SPRC to all Church members:

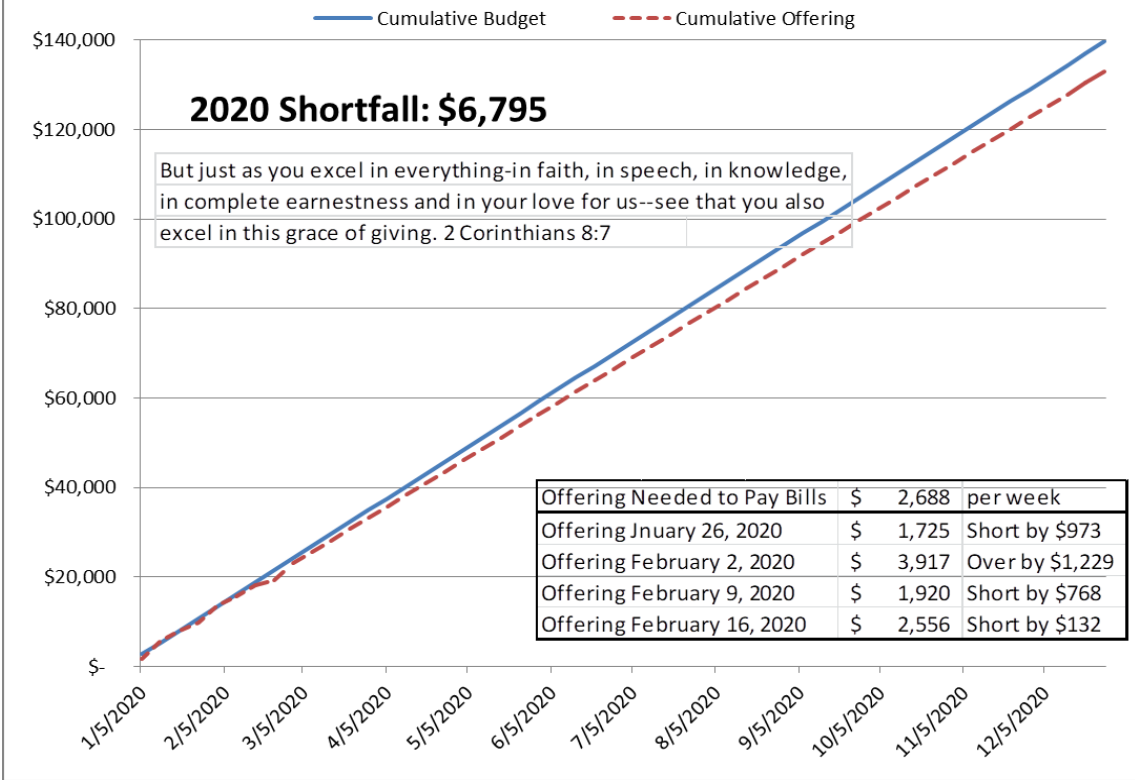
