IS THE BIBLE REALLY GOD'S WORD? 2 TIMOTHY 3:16 / 1-19-20 / A.M.

I. THE BIBLE CLAIMS TO BE GOD'S WORD.

2 PETER 1:20-21 2 Timothy 3:16

II. THE BIBLE IS A UNIQUELY WRITTEN BOOK.

- A. Comprised of 66 books.
- B. <u>40</u> different authors.
- C. Written over 1,500 years.
- D. Written in three different languages—Hebrew, Greek and Aramaic.
- E. Written in 13 different countries.
- F. Written on 3 different continents.
- G. Yet for 3,600 hundred years, God's Word continues to survive—Isa. 40:8.

III. HOW DO WE KNOW THAT THE BIBLE WE HAVE TODAY IS A FAITHFUL COPY OF THE ORIGINAL?

- A. There are no original copies of any ancient book, including the Bible.
- B. One line of evidence are the number of copies we have of the Bible.
 - 1. There are 800 copies of Homer's Iliad in existence today.
 - 2. However, there are <u>5,800</u> copies of the Bible in existence today including complete books and portions of books.
 - 3. In addition, there are 20,000 fragments of the Bible available today.
- C. Another line of evidence is the timeline between the originals and our copies.
 - 1. For example, Homer wrote the Iliad in 800 B.C. and the oldest copy dates to 400 B.C.
 - 2. The timeline between the originals of the N.T. and copies available today is much shorter.
 - a. The Chester Beatty Papyrus dates to 250 A.D.

- b. The Bodmer Papyrus dates to 200 A.D.
- c. The John Ryland Fragment of John dates to 125 B.C.
- D. How old are our copies of the O.T.?
 - 1. Before 1947 the oldest copy of the O. T. was the Masoretic Text dating to 900 A.D.
 - 2. However, in 1947 the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered containing every O.T. book except Esther. These scrolls date to 100 B.C.

IV. <u>SCIENTIFICALLY</u>, THE BIBLE IS ACCURATE.

- A. We must admit that the Bible isn't a science book.
- B. However, there other several things the Bible says that are scientifically correct. For example.
 - 1. Genesis 1:1 says the universe had a beginning.
 - 2. Jeremiah 33:22 says the stars are countless.
 - 3. Isaiah 40:22 says the earth is a circle.
 - 4. Isaiah 42:5 says the universe is expanding.
 - 5. Job 26:7 says the earth hangs on its own in space.

V. THE BIBLE IS ARCHAELOGICALLY ACCURATE.

- A. For example, archaeology has confirmed the existence of hundreds of <u>cities</u> mentioned in the Bibl.
- B. Four archaeological discoveries are worth citing.
 - 1. "The Cylinder of Nabonidus" discovered in <u>1854</u> confirms that Belshazzar was a coregent with Nabonidus and thus the last king of Babylon confirming Daniel 5.
 - 2. **"The Pilate Stone"** was discovered in <u>1961</u> in Northern Israel confirming that Pontus Pilate was governor in Israel when Jesus was crucified.
 - 3. **"The Caiaphas Ossuary"** was discovered in <u>1990</u> confirming that he was the high priest when Jesus was crucified.
 - 4. **"The Heel Bone of a Crucified Man"** discovered in <u>1968</u> is the only confirmation the Romans practiced crucifixion as a form of capital punishment at the time of Jesus.

VI. PROPHETICALLY THE BIBLE IS ACCURATE.

- A. Over one-fourth of the Bible is made of prophecies and <u>two-thirds</u> of these have already been fulfilled.
- B. Josh McDowell writes that the Bible contains <u>61</u> prophecies relating to Jesus alone, which Jesus fulfilled during his life time. Prophecies like...
 - 1. Micah 5:2—born in Bethlehem.
 - 2. Isaiah 7:14—born of a virgin.
 - 3. Isaiah 40:3—proceeded by a messenger.
 - 4. Isaiah 53:3—rejected by his own people.
 - 5. Psalms 22—crucified.
 - 6. Zechariah 12:10—pierced in his side.
 - 7. Psalms 16:10—resurrected.
- C. Statistician Peter Stoner in his book, "Science Speaks" calculated the probability of Jesus fulfilling just 8 prophecies at one hundred million billion. That's 1 followed by 17 zeros.
