**I. FIRST, THERE IS THE ENDURANCE OF DIFFICULTIES.**

A. The evidence these critics used was their racial and religious heritage—11:21b-23a.

B. Paul's evidence were the difficulties he endured—11:23b-27.

**II. SECOND, THERE IS THE BEARING OF BURDENS.**

A. Paul willingly bore the burdens of the churches—11:28.

B. These daily burdens drove Paul work all the more harder—11:23 and 11:27.

**III. THIRD, THERE IS THE REJOICING IN WEAKNESS.**

A. Most of us like to boast about the things that put us in a good light.

B. Paul boasted about things that put God in a good light.

1. Paul didn't mind talking about his weaknesses—11:30.

2. Paul gave an example—11:32-33.
