I. IS JESUS A REPUBLICAN OR A DEMOCRAT?

- A. It was George Bernard Shaw who said, “***God made man in His image, and we have decided to return the favor.***”
- B. There has always been the temptation to define God as a collective representation of ourselves.
- C. The Bible, though, calls all such projections as idolatry--Romans 1:22-23.
- D. The truth is, God is neither a Republican nor a Democrat. Why?
 - 1. He transcends all such partisan labels.
 - 2. The Apostle Paul confirms this in Galatians 3:28.

II. IF JESUS HAD A POLITICAL AFFILIATION, THOUGH, WHICH PARTY WOULD HE CHOOSE?

- A. Each major political party incorporates some of God’s truth. Its also true that no political party incorporates all of God’s truth.
- B. Jesus came to establish the Kingdom of God through his church, not to start a political party.
- C. The Promise Keepers Men’s Organization has had as their goal tearing down walls that separate people, racial and denominational walls especially. Paul tells us how this happens --2 Corinthians 5:18.
- D. Jesus also tells us how to tear down walls of separation—John 17:20-21.
