I. FIRST, WE NEED TO LEARN THAT WE LIVE IN A FREE WORLD.

- A. Why didn't God create a world where evil doesn't exist?
- B. The answer is that God did create a world like that—Gen. 1:31.
- C. God, however, also created something called "free will".
- D. Why did God create "free will"? Because He loves us and He wants us to love Him.

II. SECOND, WE NEED TO LEARN THAT WE LIVE IN A FALLEN WORLD.

- A. God didn't create evil and suffering. We did, along with Satan's help.
- B. Although God didn't create evil and suffering He can use it to accomplish His purpose—Romans 8:28.

III. THIRD, WE NEED TO LEARN THAT WE WILL LIVE IN A FUTURE WORLD

- A. Someday God will recreate this present evil world—Rev. 21:3-4.
- B. The Apostle Paul also describes this future world--1 Corinthians 2:9.
- C. God's promise of a future world without pain, evil or suffering gives us hope.
