- A. The N.T. uses two different words for honor.
1. One means to esteem or value someone.
 2. Another means to recognize the worth or dignity of someone.
- B. What should we honor someone for?
1. For what someone has done—accomplishment.
 2. For who someone is—character.
- C. What are the characteristics of someone who is worthy of honor.
1. One is humility—Prov. 15:33b.

Proverbs 15:33

...humility comes before honor.

2. Honor is given not taken or expected—Heb. 5:4.

Hebrews 5:4

...no one takes this honor on himself...
