HEB. 11:32-38 / 11-11-18 / AM

I. FIRST, WE SHOULD “RECOGNIZE” OUR VETERANS.

- A. God recognized veterans in Hebrews 11.
 - 1. Of 16 people listed by name in what’s called “God’s Honor Roll of Faith”, four are career military leaders—11:32-34.
 - 2. Since 25% of these heroes of faith were military, it’s obvious that God recognized their place and importance and we should too.
- B. Today, and every day, we should recognize those better men and women who keep us free.

II. SECOND, WE SHOULD “RESPECT” OUR VETERANS.

- A. God certainly respected the veterans He listed in Hebrews 11:38.

Hebrews 11:38
the world was not worthy of them.....

- B. How can we properly show respect for our veterans?

- 1. First, “pray” for them--2 Timothy 1:3.
- 2. Second, “provide” for them--Luke 10:7.

Luke 10:7
.....the worker deserves his wages.....

- 3. Third, “praise” them--Romans 1:8.

Romans 1:8
.....I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you

III. THIRD, WE SHOULD “REMEMBER” OUR VETERANS.

- A. God made sure we would remember these honored veterans in Hebrews 11 by including their names forever in Scripture.
- B. President Abraham Lincoln also remember veterans in another great writing, The Gettysburg Address.
